COMMANDER'S COMMENTS

Veterans,

Another fiscal year has come and gone. I think a year in review and covering the milestones of the last 12 months is in order.

Perhaps the biggest event in the last year was the recovery from the sprinkler system failure the Post experienced in December. The results are that the Post looks fantastic. The walls, ceiling, and insulation that was affected were replaced. The entire interior of the Post has been painted with a neutral bluish gray. The ceiling was painted. All the lights were replaced with LED's. The kitchen was upgraded with stainless steel fixtures, and a roll down door for the window was installed. The remaining 3/4th's of the roof has been replaced as well. The Post building should be free of any major repairs for years to come.

The Post entrance has an updated look. The honored veterans' photos have been updated with name plates and drapes being added where necessary. The Paid Up for Life plaque was updated, and another plaque procured for additional names. There is a new Riders' banner hanging that is the same size as the other banners. The water fountain was removed, and a new utility closet sink was installed. The Post gives a nice first impression when a person enters.

The American Legion Post, the Auxiliary Chapter, and the Sons of the Legion Squadron all met their membership goals for the year. When was the last time that was achieved?

There were several events held at the Post in the last 365 days. The Post held an Early Bird Membership Drive Fish Fry, a Veterans Day Dinner/Dance, a Christmas Dinner/Dance, an Army/Navy tailgate, a Super Bowl tailgate, an Awards banquet, a District revitalization event, a JROTC drill competition, and a Flag Day/Flag Retirement ceremony. Additionally, the Post built a float that was displayed in the Priceville Christmas Parade.

Post 15 was the lead veteran's organization in the local Combined Patriotic Organization. The Post led the POW/MIA, Veterans Day, and Memorial Day ceremonies during the year for the community as well as assisted with the VFW's Wreaths Across America.

The Post did not forget the children in our community. The Post chartered the Boys Scout Troop 91. It awarded six JROTC scholarships. It hosted the Post and District Oratorical Contests. It sent 17 young men to Boys State. Finally, it sponsored the Decatur High School Shooting Team.

The Post served the community in several other ways. The Honor Guard provided honors for over 50 veteran funerals. Post 15 donated approximately \$48,000 to local and veteran charities. It served as a polling site for last year's primaries and elections. It made visits to homebound veterans as well as building a handicap ramp for one of them. The Post permitted the Morgan County Rescue Squad to use the facility to have a Swamp John fundraiser. The Post Riders rode in the Purple Heart Memorial Ride.

Things continued to get better at the Post. The meals at the Post continue to improve. Each branches' birthdays are now recognized with birthday cake. The Post has procured more of the comfortable white folding chairs. The Bingo computer and software have been updated. A door to the storeroom from the kitchen was installed. A new fire suppression system for the stove was installed as well. Also, the Post, office, and garage have been cleared of a lot of unwanted clutter.

One must admit that this is a mighty impressive list of accomplishments for the year. The entire membership should take pride in these achievements.
